

## **IODE ALBERTA MASTER'S BURSARY**

In Memory of HRH Prince Philip,  
The Duke of Edinburgh

### **INFORMATION**

This is a Master's Bursary offered by the Alberta Provincial Chapter of IODE Canada. Once this is published on the website, the application process is open.

This award is intended for graduate students enrolled in a Master's Degree program within an Alberta-based University. The award is intended to support students registered in thesis-based programs, however consideration may be extended to those in a course-based Master's provided there is a specific description of how the MA relates to future employment plans.

**Value:** \$5,000 - **one only** per year as funds are available.

#### **Supporting Documents:**

- Summarize in 250 words or less the topic of your thesis and research and how it is important in lay terms.
- Summarize in 250 words or less your graduate work to date, e.g. courses completed, studies, peer-reviewed publications, as well as any volunteer activities.
- Summarize in 250 words or less your future plans.
- Transcripts (*undergraduate, and current up-to-date*).
- Two reference letters, with one from your academic advisor.

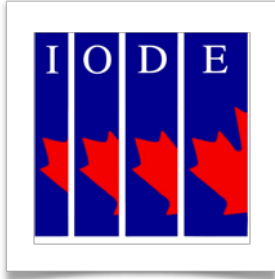
**Eligibility:** The student must be in the second year of their Master's degree program, and preferably working on their thesis, or final paper. The student must be a resident of the Province of Alberta for at least 1 year. *Application may be made from anywhere in Alberta.*

**Tenable:** Master's degree program at any **degree-granting** institution **in Alberta**.

Applications will be reviewed and the winner will be notified in May or June, 2024.

**Payment:** This bursary will be payable to a student currently a full time Master's program at any eligible\* institution in Alberta. (\*see above criteria). This award will be provided at the start of the Fall academic year, upon receipt of confirmation of attendance.

**Deadline:** March 31, 2024 (*late applications will not be considered*)
