In 1982, IODE members initiated the Labrador Bursary Fund for the purpose of granting bursaries to eager, bright and needy high school students accepted at community college, university, technical or vocational schools on their graduation.

Since inception, the Labrador Bursary Capital Account has grown from \$91,000 to over \$174,000 from donations received from IODE members and friends. Each year the interest earned provides bursaries and renewals to deserving high school graduates. IODE has encouraged hundreds of students through these bursaries, personal contact and continuing interest in their schooling and lives. Any student who maintains his or her marks receive s ongoing support to graduation.

Each year the available interest is divided between renewals and worthy new applicants. The demand far exceeds the money available. Contributions from individuals and chapters to the Labrador Bursary Fund are most welcomed.

Application Forms for the next academic year are available each year in October. New applications must be forwarded to Director of Education, Labrador School Board or Western School District by February 15th. Renewal Applications must reach IODE Canada by March 15th.

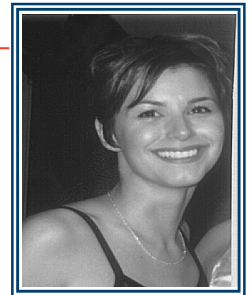
