2016 is the 98th Consecutive Year for the IODE War Memorial Scholarships



At the 116th National Annual Meeting in Toronto on 27 May 2016, IODE Canada announced the five winners of the IODE War Memorial Scholarships valued at \$15,000 each.

IODE Canada instituted the War Memorial Scholarship program in 1918 to commemorate Canadians who sacrificed their lives or were permanently disabled while fighting for Canada.

Today, applicants must be Canadian citizens, in at least their second year of a doctoral program at a Canadian or Commonwealth University and are selected for academic achievement and potential.

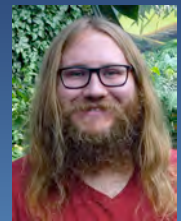
